**JOO YOUNG OH, VIOLIN**

*V*iolinist Joo Young Oh has earned international acclaim as an emerging artist on the world stage. He performs extensively in recital, as well as with orchestras and festivals in numerous countries. Recent performances have taken him to four continents: North America, Europe, Asia, and South America.

Mr. Oh's current engagements include solo performances with the Czech Radio Symphony, Prague Symphony, and St. Petersburg Philharmonic Orchestra. Recent performances have taken him to Peru (Lima), Japan (Tokyo, Osaka, Yokohama, Kobe), Dallas, Denver, and New York (Lincoln Center). Recital venues have included Los Angeles, Chicago, Atlanta, Washington D.C., Berlin, Vienna, Lyon, Sydney, and Vancouver.

Other solo appearances have included the Los Angeles Philharmonic, Seoul Philharmonic Orchestra, Ukraine National Symphony Orchestra, Aspen Music Festival, New York Symphony Orchestra, Colorado Symphony Orchestra, Slovakia Philharmonic, Hungarian Soloist Chamber Orchestra, and the 2004 World Youth Festival.

*M*r. Oh has won numerous competitions in his young career, including the 2007 National Federation of Music Clubs' Young Artist Competition. At age 11 he won his first concerto competition at Interlochen Fine Arts Camp. By age 14 he had won the Young Concert Artist International Competition in New York. Many more competition titles have followed including the Juilliard School Violin Competition. Among his most notable recognitions has been a sponsorship by the Samsung Cultural Foundation of Korea, resulting in limited time use of a rare Stradivarius violin.

Maestro Zubin Mehta once exclaimed, "Joo Young Oh has something absolutely special, and his future is truly bright." Mr. Oh has studied under such notables as Dorothy DeLay, Hyo Kang, Stephen Clapp, and Zakhar Bron.
