INSTRUCTIONS FOR AWARD APPLICANTS

COMPETITION AND AWARDS (C&A) CHART

The C&A Chart may be downloaded from www.nfmc-music.org or ordered from NFMC Headquarters, 1646 Smith Valley Rd. Greenwood IN 46142. The Chart includes only-endowed NFMC Awards. Check Individual State Federation websites for possible additional awards.

APPLICATION FORMS, INFORMATION AND SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Award requirements and application forms are available on the NFMC website www.nfmc-music.org or contact the Chair of the specific award. All NFMC Individual award applications must be <u>submitted online</u> by uploading them to the NFMC website. (*Exception:* Club Awards should be mailed to the award chair)

U.S. CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENT

Applicants for individual awards <u>must</u> be native-born/naturalized U.S. citizens. (*Exceptions:* Lynn Freeman Olson Composition, Lynn Freeman Olson Piano Pedagogy Award, Ruth Morse Wilson Handbell Award and International Music Camp—at least 50% of IMC award recipients must be U.S. citizens.)

NFMC MEMBERSHIP

Applicants <u>must be NFMC members</u> either by individual, organizational or associate group affiliation before applications are accepted. (<u>Exceptions:</u> Young Artist Awards, Ellis Piano Duo Awards, National Music Week Essay, Ruth Morse Wilson Handbell Award, Centennial Chamber Music Commendation, Summer Music Center Awards, and the three Veterans Awards.) Application forms will include specific membership information. <u>Note:</u> In competitions requiring NFMC membership, applicants must hold membership in the division in which the competition is listed (e.g. Junior entrants must be members of the Junior Division; Student entrants of the Student/Collegiate Division, etc.)

FIRST PLACE WINNER LIMITATIONS

- No individual may enter, in the same year, competitions in multiple divisions even if they hold membership in more than one division.
- No first-place winner of an <u>individual</u> NFMC award listed in the C&A Chart is eligible to compete again for the same award.
 (<u>Exception</u>: NFMC Veterans Awards where entrants may win first place awards multiple times but not consecutively, and the Jr. Composers competition in which first place winners may compete in a different category but not the same category.)
- First place winners of <u>Arts and American Music Division monetary awards</u> may win First Place multiple times, but not consecutively. (*Exceptions:* National Music Week Essay Contest) (All recognition Awards: previous winners of these awards will receive lower priority than new applicants of equal merit.)
